Purpose of Title I, Part A of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA)

• A Title I, Part A program is to provide all children with a significant opportunity to receive a fair, equitable, and high-quality education

AND

• To close educational achievement gaps

(ESEA section 1001)

Title I Eligibility

• Title I eligibility for School Year 2022-2023 is based on a minimum poverty threshold of 48.07%, which is determined by the percentage of students qualifying for free and reduced-priced meals.

Requirements for a Title I School

- **Comprehensive Needs Assessment (CNA)** must be conducted at each Title I school in order to gain a better understanding of the strengths and the contributing/root causes of the identified needs.
- **Title I Schoolwide Plan** must be written, implemented and monitored by each school. It describes how the school will improve academic achievement by addressing contributing causes of needs identified in the school's CNA.
- **Parent and Family Engagement** activities are to improve student academic achievement and school performance.
